
How to Connect to Wi-Fi on Campus



UWinnipeg uses *eduroam* to provide secure network access to students and staff.

To connect, all you need is your UWinnipeg email and WebAdvisor password.


Android. Go to available networks and select *eduroam*.



Select "View more" and ensure the EAP method is "PEAP."



Press "CA Certificate" and select "Don't validate."




Enter your UWinnipeg email into the "Identity" field and your WebAdvisor password into the "Password" field.




Press "Connect."




iOS. Go to Settings, then Wi-Fi, and select *eduroam*.




Enter your UWinnipeg email and WebAdvisor password.



Press "Join." Select "Trust" if prompted.




Windows. Click the network symbol on the task bar to bring up available networks. Select *eduroam*, then click "Connect."



Enter your UWinnipeg email and WebAdvisor password.



If prompted with "Continue connecting?", click "Connect" again.



MacOS. Locate the Wi-Fi icon on the menu bar and click it.



Select the *eduroam* network. (If you don't see it, click "Other Networks" to display nearby networks.)




Enter your UWinnipeg email and WebAdvisor password and click "OK."



You can use your UW login details to connect to the Wi-Fi at any institution which also uses eduroam, including the University of Manitoba, the Université de Saint-Boniface, and Red River College Polytechnic.
